AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Construction Site

- Open and close site facilities
- Maintain tools and equipment
- Ensure site is safe, tidy and materials are organized
- Welcome Volunteers and Build Workers; delegate tasks & present safety talk
- Supervise and assist Volunteers and Construction Apprentices; provide instruction and training as needed
- Administer basic first aid as needed

Volunteer Management

- Ensure the Food Committee Chair is aware in advance of the number of meals, snacks required each day during the construction period
- Facilitate a positive, team-oriented environment in which all volunteers and Build workers are given the opportunity to reach their full potential
