



Saugeen First Nation Build COVID-19 Precautionary Measures

Measures to be Followed

In an effort to reduce exposure and prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus during construction within the Chippewas of Nawash Unceded First Nation community, Habitat workers (paid, volunteers and sub-contractors) **shall be limited to no more than 10 per house.**

Matt Bryan, Construction Manager will ensure that all workers, volunteers and sub-contractors at the Build site adhere to the following minimum measures to control potential exposure to COVID-19:

- The symptoms of COVID-19 are like many other illnesses including the flu and cold. Any worker or sub-contractor that is sick will not be allowed on the site and will be sent home and be encouraged to complete the online self-assessment at <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/screening/worker/>
- Follow the 4 W's:
 - Watch** your distance - distancing (minimum 2 metres apart) as much as possible
 - Wear** a mask when distancing is not possible and when indoors
 - Wear** eye protection
 - Wash** your hands
- Portable toilets on each site; hand washing & paper towel stations
- PPE will be provided by Habitat including masks, gloves and safety glasses
- Workers and sub-contractors will be required to bring their lunch and snacks for breaks unless pre-arranged by Habitat
- Sub-contractors from outside the community shall not have physical contact with any member of the community and shall have access only to the Build site

Posting & Communicating Procedures

These COVID-19 procedures and any revisions must be posted in the Safety Trailer and a copy kept with the Daily Worker Logbook (sign-in binder). COVID-19 procedures (and any revisions) must be communicated verbally by Construction Manager prior to the start of work each day.
