Habitat for Humanity Grey Bruce hosted local youth in Aspire, our unique skills training program, from July 8th to August 2nd, 2024. Over 4 weeks, participants received on-the-job training, certifications, and life skills that will have a long-lasting and life-changing impact. Each participant also gained valuable knowledge of health and safety practices of homebuilding construction with employment coaching and one-on-one support. This multifaceted program followed a "3 E" framework designed to:

· Educate

· Experience

· Empower

The program is a pathway for youth to eventual meaningful and well-paying employment in the skilled trades.
