In April 2024, Don and Angie received the news that every tenant dreads. After living in their rental for 10 years, they were informed by their landlord they must find another place to call home.



Over 30 percent of the population are renters with little to no security in knowing their circumstances could change without notice. To compound this, unaffordable housing rates among renters are over twice as high as the rates amongst homeowners living in Grey and Bruce Counties. Don and Angie had four months to find a new home.

To say they were feeling overwhelmed would be an understatement. Don was entering his busy season at work, their eldest was entering high school, their youngest starting school for the first time in September and now the family was consumed with finding a new place to call home.

Homeownership rates have fallen in both Grey and Bruce Counties since 2006 - Statistics Canada The family learned of Habitat for Humanity Grey Bruce's call out for Expression of Interest submissions through a social media post. They completed their application and anxiously awaited the news.

It was all worth it when they received the call that they had been selected. Don and Angie were going to be new Habitat Homeowners!

THE TIMING WAS PERFECT...

The family was offered to take possession of their new home August 29, 2024 - 48 hours before the lease ended on their rental.

"I remember Greg (Fryer, Executive Director of Habitat Grey Bruce), sharing the news with me that the Board had selected this family... I welled up the moment he told me it was Don and Angie because I knew this opportunity would have a profound impact on their family and offer them the stability they needed."

Don and Angie still can't believe this dream come true for their family. The location of their new Habitat home allows Angie to be home to support their oldest son, Lukas, who lives with Autism. Due to their close proximity to the school, Angie can safely get Lukas on and off the bus each day and still have time to walk with Aubree to and from school.

When asked how they felt receiving the keys to their new home, Angie summed it up with one word: "ecstatic...(there is) peace of mind, knowing it's ours." Angie shared she wants people to know "just how much of a blessing it has been," to engage with the process.



Don and Angie's home was constructed by Habitat for Humanity Grey Bruce in 2009, and purchased back earlier this year from the original owners who had successfully graduated from Habitat for Humanity Grey Bruce's affordable homeownership program.

Habitat can choose to purchase back a home they've built when a homeowner wishes to sell before their 20 year mortgage term ends. This has been the case with 4 Habitat homes this year, 3 homes in Hanover and Don and Angie's home in Wiarton.
