

Youth Skills Training Program



Starting July 7th, 2025 All youth age 16-20 are eligible to participate!

"Aspire" is a 4 week entry-level skills training program, developed by Habitat Grey Bruce. Qualifying participants may be offered a potential 4 week paid work placement following successful completion of the training program. We recruit, train and employ motivated youth aged 16 to 20 years old who are interested in learning about and experiencing new home construction and renovation. An honorarium will be paid to participants for days spent at the Build site.



Our focus is to create a pathway for youth to eventual meaningful and well-paying employment.

This multifaceted program includes 1:1 coaching, mentorship and support following a "3 E" framework:



Experience – on the job at Habitat's Build site

Empower – go to the next level (trade certification; full-time employment) with increased confidence and improved opportunities

Participants are eligible to receive CSA approved safety boots and personal protective equipment (PPE). Possibility for transportation to be arranged to and from the Habitat for Humanity Grey Bruce head office located in Springmount.
